Who is the programme for?

This is a specialist vocational programme with a strong work related emphasis. The qualification provides a thorough grounding in the key concepts and practical skills required for success in business. It has national recognition by employers and allows progression within and into employment or to degree level study.

How long does it take to complete the course?

Two academic years of full time study. The HND programme will be delivered over three days. Each year is delivered in two semesters.

What entry qualifications do I need?

Entry requirements: BTEC National Diploma or 1 GCE A level or VCE A level / Double award or Access to HE Certificate and GCSE English (Grade C) and GCSE Mathematics (Grade C) or equivalent qualifications

Applications from people over 21 without the above qualifications but with relevant experience and or other qualifications are also encouraged. All applicants will be considered on their individual merit and commitment to study. All applicants will be required to attend an interview with a member of the course team and to complete an assessment

What does the programme include?

Year 1

Business Environment, Managing Financial Resources and Decisions, Organisations and Behaviour, Marketing Principles, Aspects of Contract and Negligence for Business and 3 units from: Management Accounting: Costing and Budgeting, Marketing Intelligence, English Legal Systems and Human Resources Management

Year 2

Business Decision Making, Business Strategy, Research Project and 5 units from: Working with and Leading People, Marketing Planning, Human Resource Development, Business Law, Quality Management in Business and Employability Skills

Work Experience

Students are encouraged to complete a work placement between year one and year two of the programme.
