Who is the programme for?

This is a specialist vocational programme with a strong work related emphasis. The course is designed to provide a sound introduction to Fashion and Textile design and equip students with a broad range of technical skills. It has national recognition by employers and allows progression within and into employment or to degree level study.

How long does it take to complete the course?

Two academic years of full time study. The HND programme will be delivered over three days.

What entry qualifications do I need?

Entry requirements: a BTEC National Diploma or 1 GCE A level or VCE A level / Double award or Access to HE Certificate and GCSE English (Grade C) and GCSE Mathematics (Grade C) or equivalent qualifications

Applications from people over 21 without the above qualifications but with relevant experience and or other qualifications are also encouraged. All applicants will be considered on their individual merit and commitment to study. All applicants will be required to attend an interview with a member of the course team and to complete an assessment

What does the programme include?

Year 1

Visual Communication in Art and Design, Ideas Generation and Development in Art and Design, Professional Practice in Art and Design, Contextual and Cultural Referencing in Art and Design, Garment Manufacture, Clothing Manufacture Production Operations , Pattern Drafting in Fashion, Production Techniques in Fashion

Year 2

Pattern Construction in Fashion, Fashion Promotion and Marketing, Ideas in Context, Production Techniques in Fashion, Fashion and Textiles Materials Understanding, Fashion Collection Realisation, Project Design, Implementation and Evaluation, Garment Manufacture,

What will be the costs involved?
